

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR NATIONAL TEAMS

The following criteria will be taken into consideration by the Selection Committee in selecting a national team to represent Barbados:

- 1. Players must be in good standing with the Barbados Tennis Association.
- 2. Players must play in Nationals unless excused by Council.
- 3. Current rankings.
- 4. Results of any trials held, including head to head results.
- 5. The results of the last Top 16 Tournament, where applicable, including head to head results.
- 6. Previous performances in sanctioned tournaments, in both singles and doubles, and head to head results.
- 7. Suitability of a Player's game for the type of surface for the competition and Player's experience on this surface.
- 8. Suitability of a Player's game for the position in the line-up, based on whether the Player likely to be playing singles or doubles.
- 9. Availability for competition.
- 10. Code of conduct record.
- 11. Where a Player is overseas and not available to play in local tournaments, status reports may be submitted indicating the number of tournaments played and tournament results and the number of hours in spent in training per week during the last calendar year.
- 12. On the team nomination date, Players must have satisfied all the eligibility requirements of the tournament (such as any residence requirements and the holding a valid Barbados passport) and must hold valid visas for travel to the country where the tournament is being played.
- 13. Any other relevant information which in the opinion of the Selection Committee should be taken into consideration in selecting the team.
